MIVTZA SPOTLIGHT

Each month or so, we will be running a special Mivtza — a learning initiative that focuses on themes connected to the upcoming Yomim Tovim or other significant dates on the calendar. In this section of the newsletter, we'll keep you updated on the most recent Mivtza.

MIVTZA TORAH

Right after Tishrei, we launched a special Mivtza Torah to help and encourage the bochurim with learning by Seder Girsas with more of a Geshmak. The program focuses on: 1) Learning and completing a large chunk of the Mesechta throughout the year. 2) Extra in depth tests every other week. 3) Occasional rewards for the Buchrim participating (including a special event which will take place at the beginning of Kisleiv) To make the learning more enjoyable.

MIVTZA HALIKUT

With the beginning of Chumash Bereishis we started Mivtza Halikut. Track 1) Learning 1 Sicha per week thoroughly with 3 tests throughout the Chumash. Track 2) Learning 3 Sichos per week and harder tests completing the entire volume of Likutei Sichos. With a grand trip at the end of the Chumash for those who pass all 3 tests, and make it to the Grand Halikut event by Yud Shevat.
